

NSS Grocery Distribution Report

The **NSS Unit of Keshav Memorial Institute of Commerce & Sciences (KMICS)** successfully organised a **Grocery Distribution Programme** as part of its community outreach and social responsibility initiatives. The programme was carried out at an **Old Age Home, Bhagligampally**, with the objective of supporting elderly residents by providing essential food grains.

The groceries distributed were **contributed voluntarily by Keshav Memorial NSS volunteers**, reflecting their collective commitment to service and empathy. The NSS Unit mobilised, packed, and delivered the items in an organised and respectful manner, ensuring transparency and dignity throughout the process.

As part of the distribution, the following essential food items were handed over to the Old Age Home authorities for the benefit of residents:

- **Rice:** 100 kilograms
- **Redgram (Pigeon Pea):** 100 kilograms
- **Moong Dal (Meenapappu):** 100 kilograms

The distribution was conducted smoothly in coordination with the Old Age Home management. The staff and residents expressed sincere appreciation for the timely support, which would help meet their regular dietary needs. NSS volunteers also interacted with the elderly residents, reinforcing values of compassion, respect, and social responsibility.

This initiative provided meaningful experiential learning to students and strengthened the bond between the institution and the community. The programme reaffirmed the NSS motto of *“Not Me, But You”* and highlighted the positive impact of collective effort and voluntary service.
