

External Academic Audit Team's Observation for AY 2022-23

- Curriculum Evaluation: Overall, the curriculum is in satisfactory conformity with
  industry norms and requirements for future employment markets. Nonetheless,
  deficiencies have been found in some specialized fields, especially in newly
  developing areas like sustainable development and technology use. It is observed that
  there are insufficient interdisciplinary courses and chances for students to investigate
  cross-cutting subjects. Enhancing the academic experience could be achieved by
  providing more diversified elective courses and promoting multidisciplinary
  collaborations.
- Faculty Assessment: Faculty members' qualifications are sufficient to fill academic
  positions. Nonetheless, in order to stay current with developments in their respective
  domains and pedagogical techniques, ongoing professional development programs are
  required.

 Infrastructure Review: Well-equipped classrooms, labs, and library spaces provide sufficient support for the academic activities offered by the college. To guarantee that learning opportunities remain uninterrupted, there are, however, sporadic maintenance concerns that require immediate correction.

- 4. <u>Student Performance Analysis</u>: Metrics related to student performance show acceptable graduation rates and academic accomplishments. Retention rates, however, are clearly declining, especially for students from marginalized backgrounds. Additional investigation shows that academic support programs like counselling and tutoring are not being used to their full potential. This problem might be lessened by putting pre-emptive initiatives in place to assist at-risk students and improve academic advising services.
- 5. <u>Compliance and Governance:</u> The College exhibits adherence to legal and accreditation requirements. Nonetheless, there exist prospects to optimize administrative procedures and augment transparency in the process of making decisions.

# 6. Suggestions:

- > Create and put into place a methodical procedure for curriculum evaluation and updating in order to take into account new trends and requests from the market.
- > Fund faculty development programs that emphasize the growth of research capacity, technological integration, and creative teaching approaches.
- > Set priorities for maintenance and upgrades to the infrastructure according to usage trends and recognized needs.
- > Increase the availability of student support services and carry out focused interventions to raise graduation and retention rates.
- > Improve governance frameworks and set up procedures for continuing observation and assessment

These results give a thorough picture of the college's academic performance and point out areas that need to be improved to improve both students' and teachers' overall educational experiences.

- It enhance opportunities for experiential learning, internships, and hands-on experiences within the curriculum. Establish partnerships with industry organizations to provide students with real-world learning opportunities..
- Institution has mechanisms in place for assessing student learning outcomes, there is room for improvement in terms of the effectiveness and consistency of these assessments across different programs and departments.

- 6. Prioritized recommendations for infrastructure investments to support teaching, research, and learning activities.

## 7. Suggestions:

- > The audit found that the institution's curriculum is generally well-aligned with its stated educational goals and objectives. However, there were instances where course content appeared outdated or not fully aligned with current industry trends and standards.
- > The audit identified opportunities for promoting interdisciplinary approaches within the curriculum to better prepare students for the complex challenges they may encounter in their professional careers.
- > Collect feedback from students, faculty, and stakeholders regularly to identify areas for improvement and make data-driven decisions.

By implementing these suggestions and fostering a culture of academic excellence, institutions can create a supportive and enriching environment that empowers students to succeed academically and make meaningful contributions to society.

 Adequately equipped classrooms, labs, and library areas offer ample support for the academic programs the college offers. However, there are occasionally maintenance issues that need to be fixed right away in order to ensure that learning opportunities continue.

External Academic Audit Team's Observation for AY 2018-19

- The curriculum complies satisfactorily with industry standards and the demands of upcoming job markets. However, shortcomings have been discovered in several specialized disciplines, particularly in areas that are still emerging, including technology utilization and sustainable development.
- The qualifications of faculty members are adequate to staff academic roles. However, continuing professional development programs are necessary to stay up to date with advancements in their respective fields and pedagogical approaches.
- Academic Calendars /Departmental Calendars are not maintained properly including circulars.
- For FDPs, workshops Circulars, Brochures, Program sheet, details of sessions, are not maintained properly.
- Metrics related to student performance show acceptable graduation rates and academic accomplishments. Retention rates, however, are clearly declining, especially for students from marginalized backgrounds.
- The College demonstrates compliance with accreditation and legal standards.
   However, opportunities do exist to streamline administrative processes and enhance
   decision-making openness.

7. Suggestions:

- Establish and implement a systematic process for curriculum assessment and revision to accommodate emerging trends and market demands.
- Provide financial support for initiatives aimed at enhancing faculty research capabilities, incorporating technology, and fostering innovative pedagogical methods.
- To improve graduation and retention rates, expand the availability of student support services and implement targeted interventions.

These findings paint a complete picture of the college's academic standing and highlight areas in which enhancements are required to enhance the entire educational experience for both instructors and students.
