A structured approach towards achieving a better grade in NAAC accreditation was illustrated through a flowchart, outlining key activities:

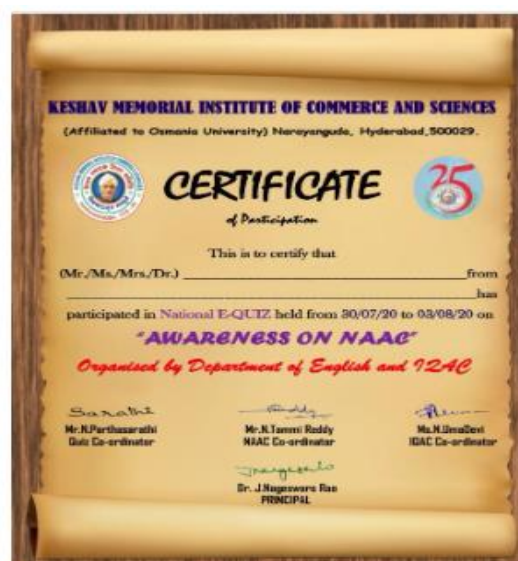
1. Activities

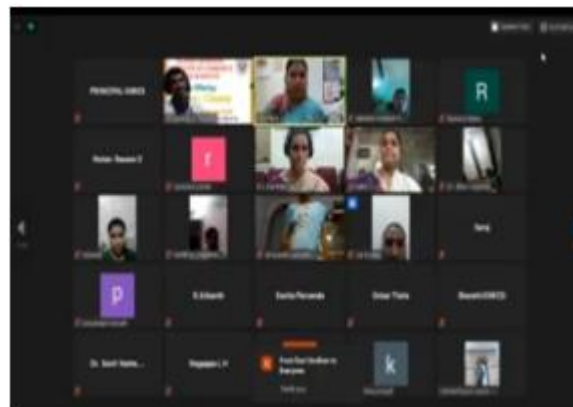
Participants actively engaged in discussions, exchanged ideas, and gained practical knowledge to enhance their teaching skills and competencies.

05.12.2020 Webinar on “New Age Skills for A Journey Called Life”

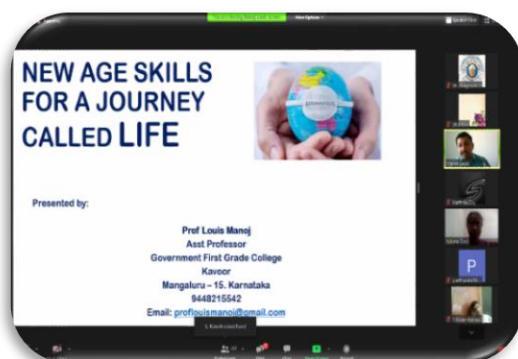
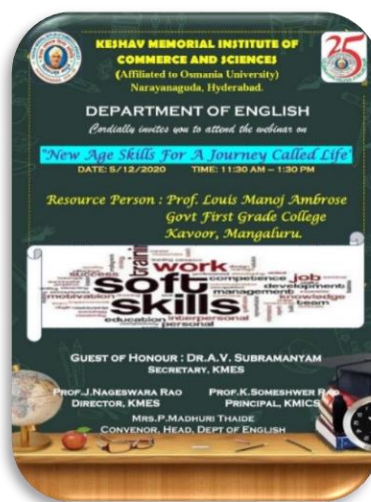

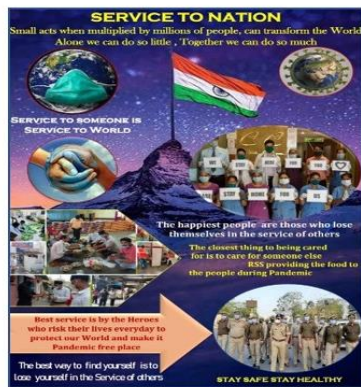
21 /06/2021 to 24/06/2021 - Inter-Collegiate Digital Poster Presentation Competition

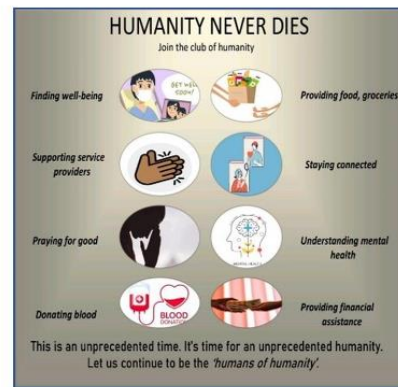
