

## 06.07.2021 Sri Harihara Sarma Memorial Lecture on NEP 2020 Skill India

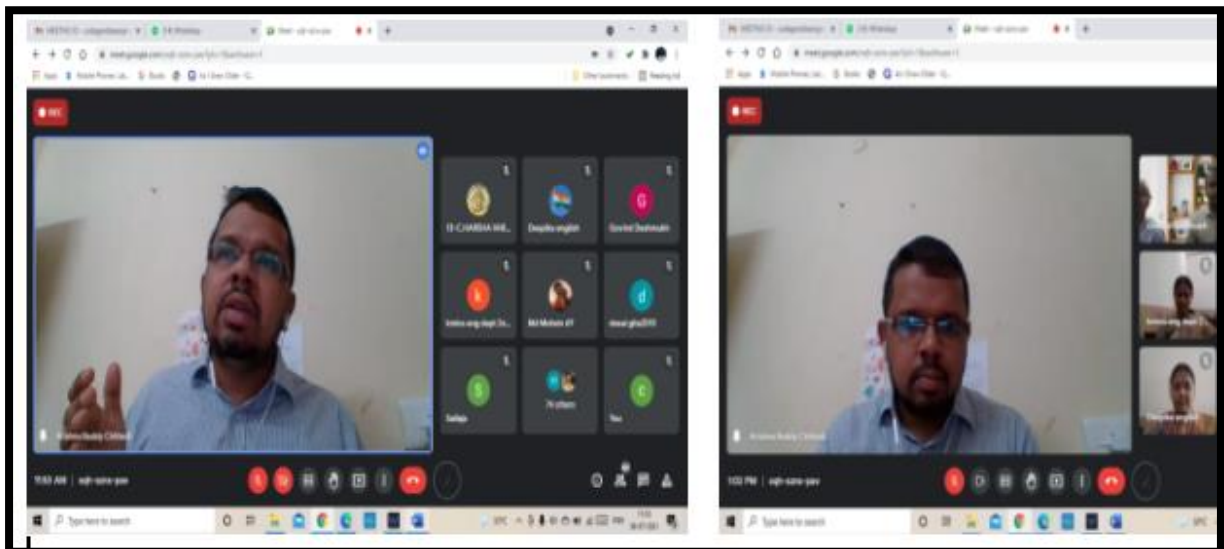

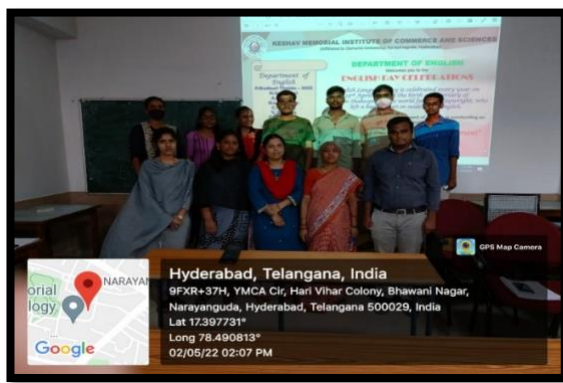


## 02.05.2022 Essay Writing Competition as a part of English Day Celebrations

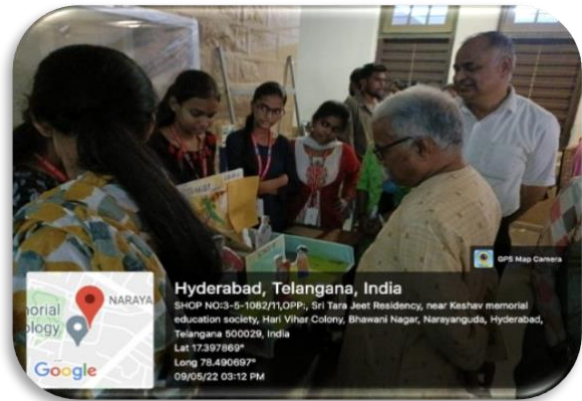
