Surya Sen also called Surya Kumar Sen, was an Indian revolutionary who was influential in the Indian independence movement against British rule in India and is best known for leading the 1930 Chittagong armoury raid.

He was influenced by the nationalist ideals in 1916 while he was a student of B.A. in Berhampore College (Now MES College). Sen was a school teacher by profession and was popularly known as Master Da. He was an active participant in the Non-co-operation movement and was later arrested and imprisoned for 2 years from 1926 to 1928 for his revolutionary activities.

Sen was again arrested on 16 February 1933, the British officials entered the cell of the prisoner, and dragged him out. For the next few hours or so, the prisoner would be subjected to the worst possible torture ever. His teeth were broken, his limbs and joints were broken with a hammer. All his nails were pulled out, and his unconscious body was dragged to the gallows, where he was hanged to death. The dead body was later put in a small case and thrown into the sea.
